Dear Valued Customer,

I am writing to let you know about a data security incident that may involve customer credit card data entered through your POS System. We recently discovered that our Log-Me-In account was breached on February 28, March 5, and April 18, 2014. We have reason to believe that the data accessed could include credit card information from any cards used by your customers between these dates.

Upon discovery, ISS changed all of our Log-Me-In credentials and instituted a secondary unique password to guard against further malicious activity. We are in the process of running virus protection/detection at all of our sites. We believe the cards that were compromised would have been used between the February 28<sup>th</sup> and April 18<sup>th</sup> time frame.

If you are notified by any of your customers that they believe their card was compromised through use at your location, please advise them to contact their financial institution as soon as possible.

We regret that this happened, are sorry for any difficulties it may cause, and have taken additional action to protect this from happening again. We value your business and will continue to strive to give you the best possible service and support.
